Extra meals and other food items will still be available for purchase at the 2016-2017 approved prices.

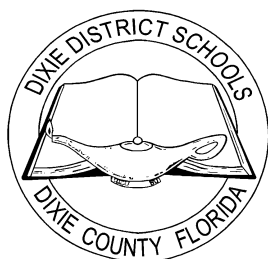
Due to district budget, this program will be re-evaluated annually to determine if funds are available to continue the program.
