

NOTICE OF TAX FOR SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY

The School Board of Dixie County will soon consider a measure to continue to impose a 1.50 mill property tax for the capital outlay projects listed herein.

This tax is in addition to the school board's proposed tax of 5.422mills for operating expenses and is proposed solely at the discretion of the school board.

The capital outlay tax will generate approximately \$758,446 to be used for the following projects:

CONSTRUCTION AND REMODELING

- One (1) New High School
- District Wide Remodeling Projects
- District Wide Small Projects and Walkways
- Plant Survey Construction Projects

MAINTENANCE, RENOVATION, AND REPAIR

- Reimbursement of the maintenance, renovation, and repairs paid through the General Fund as permitted by Florida Statute
- Facilities Maintenance, Repairs, and Improvements District wide
- Painting and Fencing
- Paving Projects, Parking Lots, and Access Roads including Resurfacing
- Storm Water Management
- HVAC/Fire Alarms/Sprinkler/Communications/Security/Safety/Energy Management
