

2011 FCAT and EOC Scores Increase Across District

Last week, the Florida Department of Education released the remaining FCAT scores and the new End of Course results for the first administration of the Algebra I assessment. A look at the total 2011 FCAT results reveal schools across Dixie District Schools improved in 14 areas over the state average for 2011 as well improving in 14 areas over the 2010 FCAT results.

The new Algebra I End of Course (EOC) exam was administered for the first time to 8th and 9th grade students. This assessment was given on-line over a 160-minute testing period. The mean scale score for Algebra I students in Dixie also exceeded the state average.

Superintendent Mark Rains stated, “We have worked hard this year and we are seeing the results of those efforts. We still have areas of focus for next year and our principals have many ideas and plans to address the needs in those areas. Overall, we are extremely proud of our students, parents, teachers and administrators.”
